

ANTONIO FRESCO BIOGRAPHY

Born in Silver Spring, Maryland and having grown up in Baltimore, this DJ, Music Producer, and radio host is far from your ordinary, “run of mill” radio personality. With his Puerto Rican and Dominican roots, this Afro-Latino got his start in radio at Morgan State University's WEAA-FM, co-hosting the “Strictly Hip Hop” show while attending the school. Months after, he made the jump over to major market commercial radio when he started work at WKYS-FM in Washington, DC. Just a few short months after, Fresco found his self in Dallas, Texas on the market-topping urban outlet, 97.9 The Beat.

Fast forward seven years later, Fresco moved to Los Angeles to pursue his passion for music, focusing on music production and songwriting. Here is where he was able to brand himself as not only a DJ, but as a recording artist as well, having released several singles such as “Lose Myself”, “Leading Me On” and “Make Ya Move.” However he would soon learn that radio was still in his future. In the fall of 2020, he secured a spot on Miami's top 40 outlet, HITS 97.3.
